2009 - July 9th Store Opening

2010 - Hired my first employee Sally Mengel who later launched Loblolly Creamery in our space

2011 - Acquired antique shelving and fixtures from Park West Pharmacy which included our marble counter and soda fountain similar to what would have been in Dawson Drug Store. And that was the genesis for Sally to launch Loblolly Creamery which operated inside our store before moving next door in 2016.

2013 - Natural Awakenings Natural Choice awards names us **Green Business of the Year**

2017 - Nov 16th - Tea Bar opens


Earth Day is Every Day at The Green Corner Store
